An extra-legal vehicle or load may travel on state highways twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week, EXCEPT as follows:

1. An extra-legal vehicle or load greater than 14 feet wide is prohibited from travel during the hours of darkness.
2. An extra-legal vehicle or load less than 14 feet traveling at night shall comply with the following requirement:
a. All lighting required by $\S \S 42-4-203$ through 42-4-234, C.R.S., and the Commercial Vehicle Rules, as applicable.
b. If the extra-legal vehicle or load is not more than twelve feet in width:
i. A flashing yellow light shall be mounted on the front of the vehicle.
ii. At least two but not more than three flashing yellow lights shall be mounted to the extreme rear.
c. If the extra-legal vehicle or load is more than twelve feet in width but not more than fourteen feet in width:
i. On all two-lane highways, one pilot escort vehicle shall be in the front.
ii. On all four-lane highways, one pilot escort vehicle shall be in the rear.
d. If an extra-legal vehicle or load exceeds the legal limits for length or has an overhang:
i. A flashing yellow light shall be mounted to the front of the vehicle.
ii. The permittee shall attach at least one but not more than three yellow or red cluster light to the overhang, as follows: If the overhang is in the rear, red cluster lights shall be used. If the overhang is in the front, yellow cluster lights shall be used.
3. Holiday Restrictions:
a. Travel is prohibited from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.
(This provision does not apply to LVCs)
i. When Independence Day falls on a Saturday travel is prohibited on the previous Friday from 12:00 noon until 9:00 p.m.
ii. When Independence Day falls on a Sunday travel is prohibited on the following Monday from 12:00 noon until 9:00 p.m.
iii. Travel is prohibited on the Friday preceding Labor Day and Memorial Day between 12:00 noon and 9:00 p.m.
b. LVC Provision: An LVC is prohibited from travel on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.
i. When Independence Day falls on Saturday travel is prohibited on the previous Friday.
ii. When Independence Day falls on Sunday travel is prohibited on the following Monday.
iii. When New Year's Day or Christmas Day falls on Saturday travel is prohibited on the previous Friday.
iv. When New Year's Day or Christmas Day falls on Sunday travel is prohibited on the following Monday.
